How are we making school safe?



We will check for risks before school is open.



Everyone will wash their hands regularly.



If a child or family member is sick they can not come into school



School will be cleaned regularly.



There will be less children in a room together



To do this we will need to make changes to the school day

Does my child have to come into school?



If your child is well and in Reception, Year1 or Year 6 they will be asked to attend school



There will be no fines if your child does not go to school.

Who can come to school?

Children in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 need to stay at home

If your child is in one of these year groups you will be given the days and times they can attend. In order to keep everyone safe the school week will look different.

What will a day look like?

You will arrive at school at a time given to you.

You will go through this doors:

You will be in a *class bubble group*- you will stay in this group at all times.

Classrooms will look a little different from normal. Everyone will stay 2 metres apart. You will have your own stationary, tissues and resources and table to keep your things.

You will not be bringing anything in from home or be taking anything home from school either. We will have what you will need in school.



Lunch and playtimes

All playtimes and lunch times will be staggered throughout the day so we limit the number of people on the playground.



Children will be eating their lunch in the room they are in.

Playtimes and lunch times will be spread out across the day so we limit how many children are on the playground at a time so everyone can stay 2 metres apart.

No water bottles, snacks or lunchboxes are to be brought into school.

Children will be able to get drinks of water using disposable cups throughout the day.

School will provide children with a morning snack.

All children will be provided with a school packed lunch provided free of charge from the kitchen.



At playtimes and lunchtimes children will remain in their class bubble group and need to endeavour to remain 2 metres apart. Children are not to mix with other year groups or children not in their class bubble.

We will have games and activities set up at lunchtime children can play. They will be looked after by a lunchtime supervisor.

All outdoor play equipment is out of bounds

What will we be doing in school?

- Reading
- Circle times and other PSHE activities
- Using key maths skills
- Art activities
